



# New Life Program at CHR's Center of Excellence for Women / Women and Children

Being a new mother while struggling with a substance abuse issue can feel like too much to handle. At CHR's New Life Program we are here to provide help, hope and support so that women can realize that **new beginnings are within reach.**

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The New Life Program for Women and Children is a residential treatment program offering intermediate level of care for women with infants and toddlers and/or expectant mothers with a history of substance abuse and mental health issues. New Life helps women achieve recovery and maintain a healthy lifestyle with a focus on developing effective parenting skills. Mothers and children are able to stay 4-6 months, based on each woman's individualized treatment plan. Methadone services are available through our Pathways Medication Assisted Treatment Program. Our comprehensive services are recovery-oriented, gender-responsive and trauma-informed. New Life is part of CHR's Center of Excellence for Women/Women and Children located at our Putnam campus.

## THE PROGRAM INCLUDES:

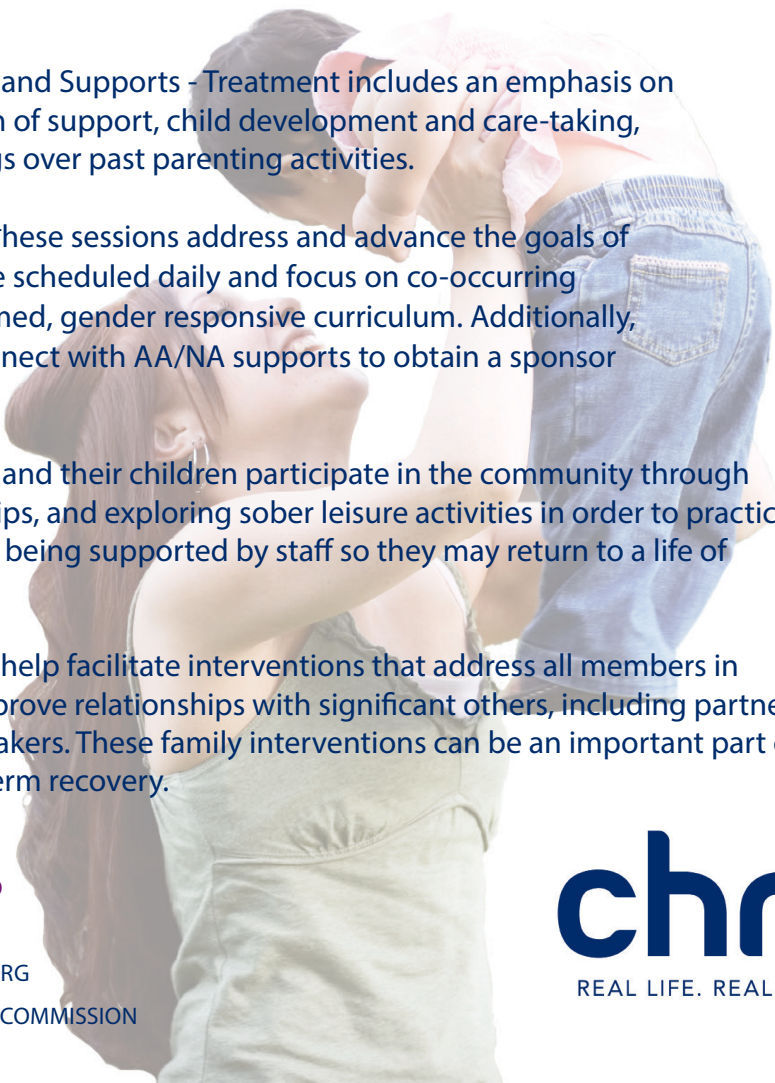
- Parenting and Infant/Child Services and Supports - Treatment includes an emphasis on parenting skills, developing a system of support, child development and care-taking, skill building, and addressing feelings over past parenting activities.
- Individual and Group Counseling - These sessions address and advance the goals of individualized care plans. Groups are scheduled daily and focus on co-occurring disorders through our trauma-informed, gender responsive curriculum. Additionally, women are educated on how to connect with AA/NA supports to obtain a sponsor and support resources.
- Independent Living Skills - Mothers and their children participate in the community through medical appointments, shopping trips, and exploring sober leisure activities in order to practice their independent living skills while being supported by staff so they may return to a life of recovery in their communities.
- Family-Centered Interventions - We help facilitate interventions that address all members in the family and include efforts to improve relationships with significant others, including partners, parents, siblings, children and caretakers. These family interventions can be an important part of the woman's preparation for long-term recovery.
