Exhibit: 10:00 am – 2:00 pm Lecture: 12:00 pm



Black History Month (A.K.A. African-American History Month) has been celebrated throughout the month of February in the United States since 1970. The month-long celebration, which originated as a weeklong celebration during the second week of February, was created as a way of remembering important events and people of the African diaspora. Black History Month was first proposed by the Black United Students at Kent State University and Black educators in 1969, leading to the first celebration a year later. In 1976, Black History Month was recognized by President Gerald Ford.
