



## 2023 Annual Report of Sexual Safety

CHR has a strong commitment to the safety of our clients through the creation of a zero-tolerance culture toward any sexual abuse, sexual harassment or retaliation of those individuals who report or cooperate in an investigation of such misconduct. All CHR programs will comply with federal and respective state laws as they pertain to the Prison Rape Elimination Act which was signed into law in 2003 by President George W Bush.

CHR has appointed Lisa Odgren as the agency PREA Coordinator for Milestone. This individual works with facility and agency leadership to ensure client safety. The PREA Coordinator ensures that all standards are continuously assessed to maintain an ongoing culture of compliance and safety. The PREA Coordinator ensures.

- that all staff are trained annually on PREA
- that clients are educated about the Zero Tolerance policy toward Sexual Abuse or sexual harassment of client rights related to PREA
- That all clients are screened for risk and appropriate safety measures are in place.
- Ensures all allegations are investigated.
- Maintain data sufficient the US DOJ Survey of Sexual Violence
- Remains aware of community resources for victims of abuse

### Education
