



## Intimate Partner Violence

We offer hope to families dealing with intimate partner violence because everyone deserves to feel **safe** at home.

Intimate Partner Violence is a cruel cycle that hurts families over and over—but there is hope. CHR's Intimate Partner Violence program provides intensive clinical and case management services for families who have experienced domestic violence. These primarily in-home services take into account all family members, including child and adult survivors as well as the offender. Our program focuses on increasing safety, reducing trauma, improving the parent-child relationship and helping non-offending adults and children stabilize their lives after abuse. By educating families about the impact of domestic violence on each other and especially their children, we can help break the cycle.

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### HOW WE CAN HELP

There are two separate models of treatment provided separately to each parent: Mothers and More and Fathers for Change. Our overall goals are to address safety concerns, end violence, teach emotion regulation skills, improve parenting and co-parenting skills. Children are also incorporated into treatment to improve parent-child relationships. Our core services include:

- Safety planning
- Trauma-focused work
- Case management and access to resources
- Assessment and referral for other mental health or substance use services

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### COORDINATING CARE

A key element of our Intimate Partner Violence program is that we help coordinate and share information between agencies including child welfare; adult, family and civil courts; offender intervention services; and victim advocate services. With key agencies sharing a common understanding, we can work together to ensure that an appropriate and coordinated response is available when needed.

### WORKING TOGETHER FOR POSITIVE CHANGE
