



Child Intensive Outpatient Program in East Hartford

Real Hope and support starts here. CHR's Child Intensive Outpatient Program is here to help youth and their families.

CHR's Child Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) located in East Hartford is designed to support **adolescents ages 12–17** experiencing anxiety, depression, and trauma related challenges who would benefit from a more structured and intensive treatment model. Child IOP meets three days per week from 2- 5 p.m. Adolescents will participate in group sessions focused on psychoeducation, skill building, and improvement in overall well-being, as well as weekly one-on-one therapy and access to one of our psychiatric medication practitioners. Family involvement is a key and intentional part of our treatment approach; we require participation in bi-weekly family sessions. Our multidisciplinary approach aims to stabilize mental health symptoms and maintain adolescents in their homes, schools, and communities; prevent hospitalizations; and assist in the warm handoff to a reduced level of care treatment option.

OUR CHILD IOP SERVICES

- Comprehensive clinical assessments
- Crisis support and intervention
- 24/7 on-call emergency professional coverage
- Psychiatric evaluation, recommendations, and medication management for youth in therapy
- Treatment of depression, anxiety, PTSD, and co-occurring substance use problems
- Group and family therapy required; individual therapy, as needed
- Time-limited, effective treatment
- Collaboration and coordination with other community resources (i.e. schools, pediatricians)
- Caregiver support
- Services in your primary language including Spanish/bilingual providers and translator services

EVIDENCE-BASED, OUTPATIENT TRAUMA TREATMENTS

CHR's Child IOP curriculum uses a combination of evidenced-based, outpatient trauma treatments, including Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Motivational Enhancement Therapy/Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (MET/CBT), in addition to wellness activities.

CBT is a proven behavioral intervention to help youth and their parents (or other caregivers) identify, change, and cope with negative thinking patterns and behaviors.

MET/CBT is a combined, evidence-based practice that CHR uses to effectively treat trauma, substance use, and more. This person-centered approach focuses on an individual's motivation to change, coupled with behavioral intervention to provide individuals with the skills to cope.

Wellness activities such as mindfulness, health education, and stress reduction skills.
