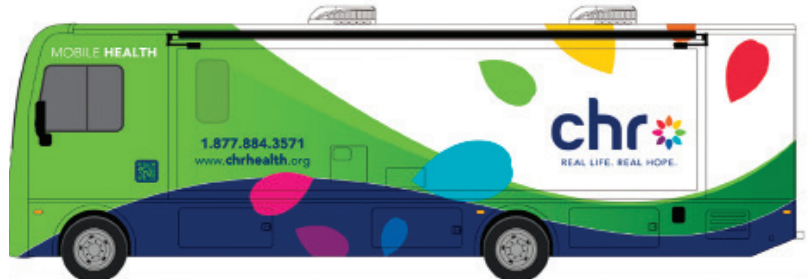

CHR's Mobile Pathways Program provides personalized, effective, and recovery-focused treatments to people across Northeastern CT who are seeking recovery from Opioid Use Disorders. Services include:

- Medications for Opioid Use Disorders, including Methadone
- Same-day admissions provided by on-site prescribers and nurses, as well as initial and annual physicals
- Recovery-focused counseling from clinicians
- Ongoing support from on-site Recovery Support Specialists - people in recovery who will share their stories, struggles, and successes, and guide you on your journey to recovery
- Access to Narcan, fentanyl test strips, and more

CHR's Mobile Pathways Program RV is over 33 feet long, eight feet wide, and 12 feet high, with a total weight of 22,000 pounds. It is fully outfitted to provide complete, comfortable, and respectful care to those we serve.
